Breathe your Spirit into us, and raise us to new life, that we may be living evidence of your resurrection, the Body of the risen Christ. Amen.


Hymn 90 Ye Watchers and ye Holy Ones vs 1-3

Lord, listen to your children praying, Lord send your spirit in this place, Lord, listen to your children praying; send us love, send us power, send us grace.




Pastoral Prayer said by Pastor


1 Breathe on me, breath of God: fill me with life anew, that I may love as you have loved and do as you would do.

Hymn 2117 Spirit of God vs 1,2,5


